

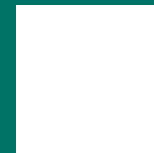




Lead confidently.

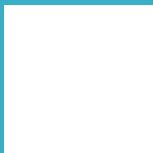

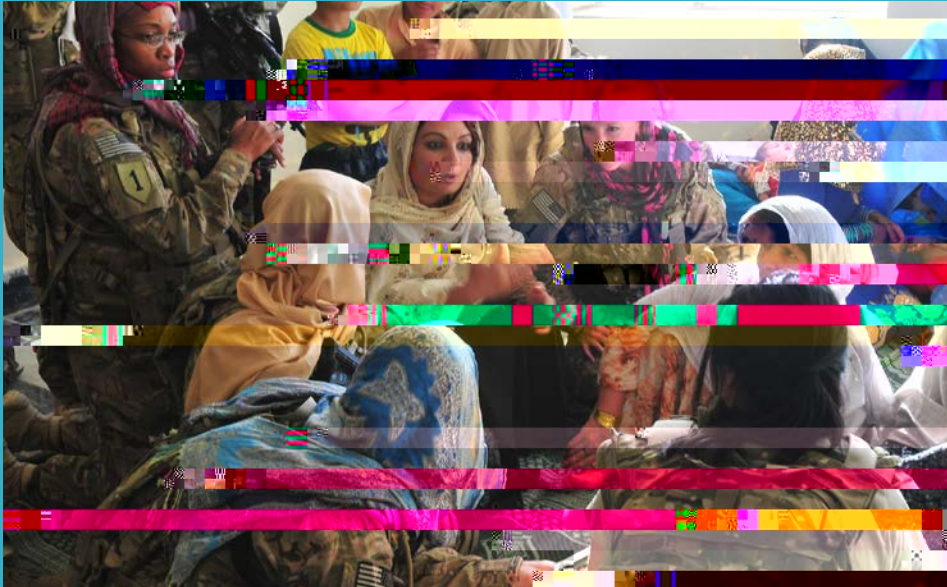

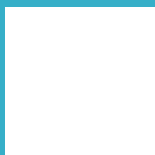

Whether you are leading a platoon in the Army or speaking in a board room, bold leadership is a prerequisite to success. At UNG, we specialize in bold.



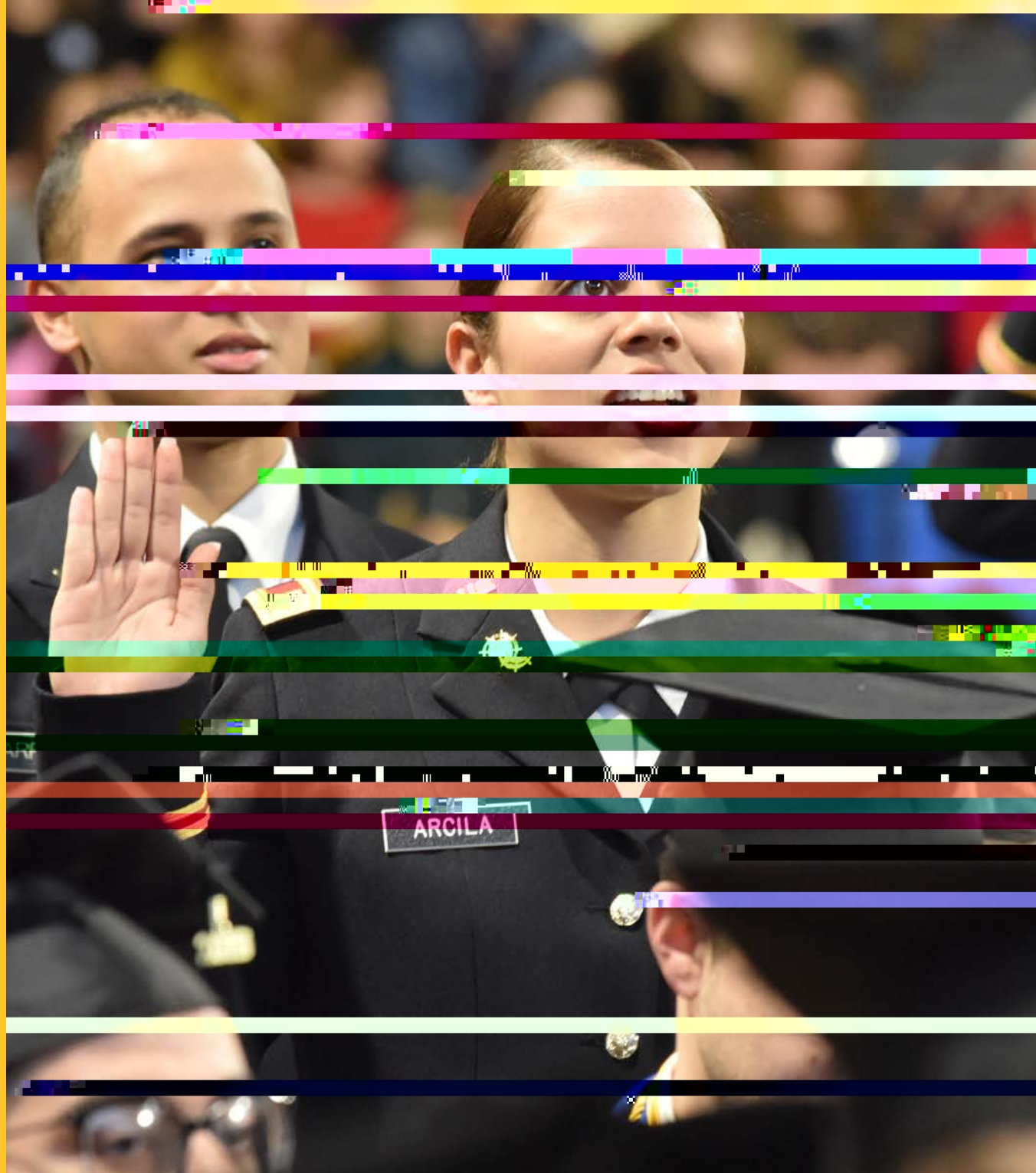

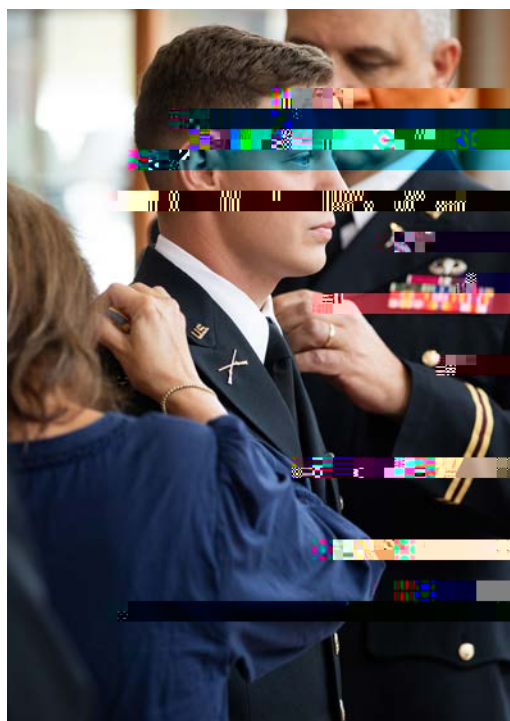
