The University of North Georgia of ers degree programs that meet the educational requirements students need to apply for professional licensure or certification in Georgia. The programs may not meet the education requirements for licensure or certification in other states.

Students who plan to pursue professional licensure should contact the program coordinator and appropriate licensing entity for additional information and guidance.

Upon successful completion of the program, University of North Georgia graduates will have requirements and will be eligible to sit for the certification exam required for practice as an FPN.
